Qualifying for an anti-social behaviour case review


- Have you reported 3 separate, related incidents in the last 6 months?
- Has each incident been reported within 1 month of it happening?
- O pou feel that no effective action has been taken?

If so, you have the right to request an anti-social behaviour case review (previously known as the Community Trigger). You can apply directly or have someone apply on your behalf if you provide written consent.

Will it make a difference?

It's effective because the authorities look at the situation together and agree coordinated actions to tackle the issue.

To start the process, contact your local council or visit their website



Note: This process is for tackling persistent, unresolved issues not for reporting new anti-social behaviour
